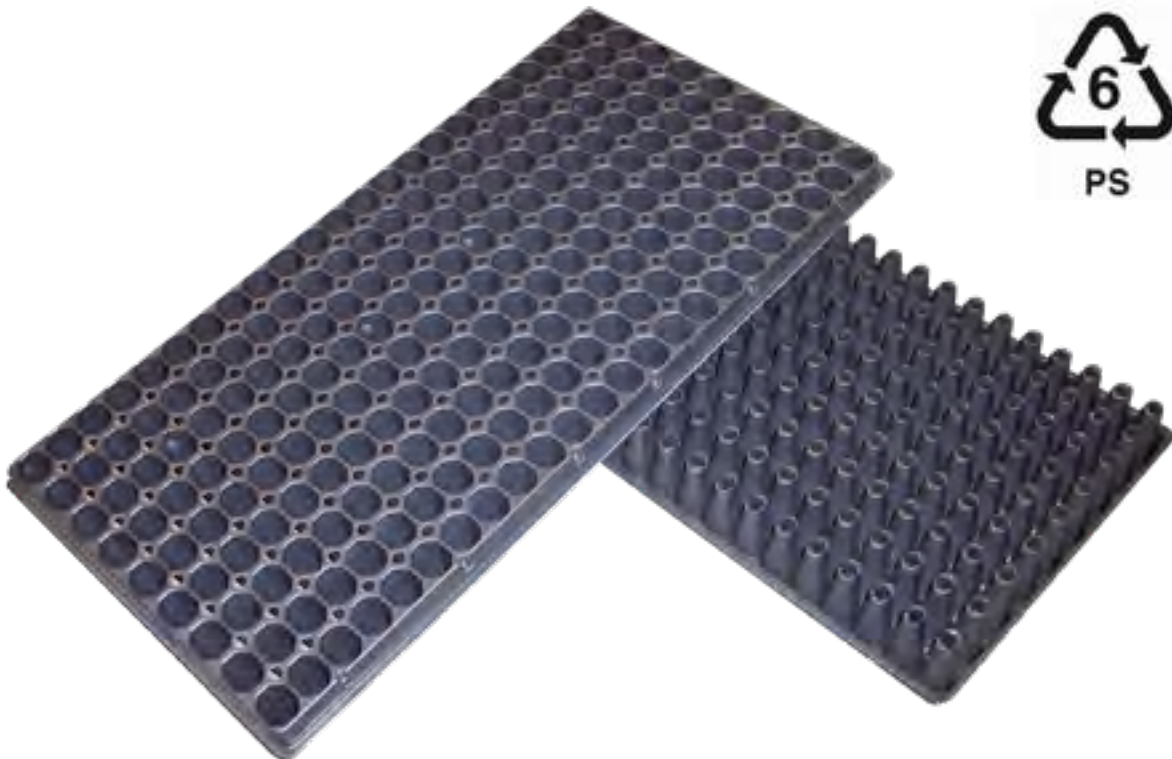

## Recycling Through A.M.A.

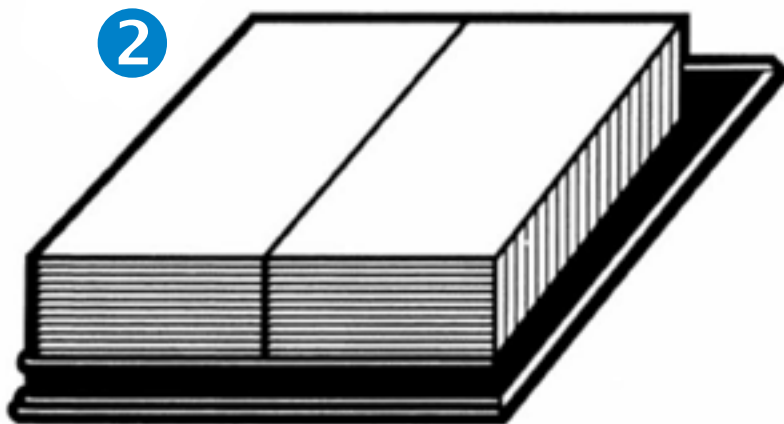
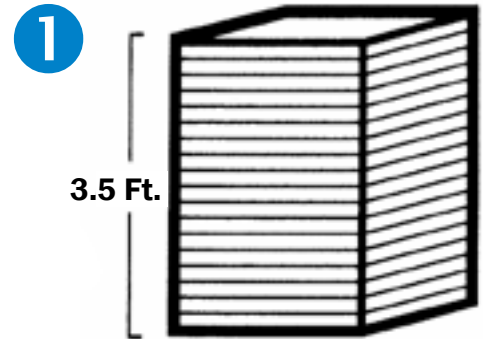
- A.M.A. can help you save on disposal fees for used polystyrene trays by picking up your used, reasonably clean (that means the soil is knocked out) trays. Just follow the stacking instructions on the reverse. We'll take a 1/2 pallet and up.
- A.M.A. tries to do all the pick-ups of used trays in late spring and over the summer. We schedule the pick-ups with growers for our return runs to keep cost down. If you would like us to pick up your used polystyrene trays, just call us at 800-338-1136 and ask for John or email us at ama@amahort.com. Sorry, Southwestern Ontario only.
- Please ensure there is NO other plastic material except for polystyrene trays in the pile. This is critical.



# Planter Tray Shipping

Freight costs are a major factor in any successful recycling program. Now that you have decided to have your polystyrene plug or bedding plant trays recycled through A.M.A., please observe the following packaging instructions:

1. Nest trays together in piles approximately 3.5 ft. (42") high
2. Lay each pile on its side (long side) on pallet. You should be able to lay two piles on each layer.



3. Make 7 to 9 layers per pallet (criss-cross each layer for increased stability). This should make the height of each pallet approximately 7 ft. to 8 ft. To secure trays, either stretch wrap or strap to pallet.

4. A full load of trays will be 24-26 pallets. The weight of each pallet will be between 800-1,000 pounds (350-450 kilograms).

By following this simple procedure, we can guarantee that transportation is as efficient as possible.
